- Student must be accepted as a full-time student by either a business, trade or college institution

PAOA Scholarship Review Committee selects the winners based on the following scoring points:

- 30 points Academic Achievement/GPA
- 20 points Essay
- 20 points Applicant's PAOA participation (Volunteering in PAOA activites)
- 15 points Student Leadership and/or Extracurricular Activities (ex: Student Government, Orchestra, ROTC, etc.)
- 10 points Parent/s current and active member of PAOA, Inc. or another Non-Profit Organization. (certificate of appreciation or letter for volunteer services proof required).
